Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus (1:1)

- · AD 33/34 Conversion of Paul
- · AD 52-57 > Paul's 3rd missionary journey
- ·AD 62 > Paul arrested, writes Ephesians

#### About original audience:

- · to the churches in Ephesus
- · Ephesus > one of the largest cities in Rome / Roman Empire
- 'written to "the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus." (1:1)

### About original time/place of writing:

- · Written ground AD 62
- · written while Paul was in Prison in Rome
- · Ephesians was delivered by Tychicus

#### About historical situation:

Paul is offering general instructions in the truths of God's redemptive Work in Christ.

b includes the proper conduct in the church, the home, and in the world.
